

## **Preparing a Farm or Facility Map**

This document provides guidance on how to prepare a farm or facility map to meet the requirements for organic certification.

## Farm Maps

Primary producer operations seeking organic certification must provide a detailed farm/production unit map (or maps) as part of their application. This can be based on an aerial photograph, cadastral map, or hand-drawn map, as long as it can be clearly read and understood. Please use the checklist below to ensure that you have included all required information on your farm map:

- $\Box$  Farm name and address.
- $\Box$  Farm borders/boundaries.
- □ Borders/boundaries for all organic, in-conversion and conventional fields.
- $\Box$  Field names/numbers.
- $\Box$  Field size (ha).
- $\Box$  Neighbouring land use.
- $\Box$  Buffer zones, if applicable.
- $\Box$  Slopes, if applicable.
- □ Landmarks such as buildings, farm or public roads, railroad tracks, etc.
- $\Box$  Windbreaks, hedgerows or woodlands.

Additional requirements for ruminant livestock producers:

- $\hfill\square$  Location, size and identification of pastures.
- $\Box$  Feeding areas, if applicable.
- $\Box$  Location and types of permanent fences.
- $\Box$  Location and source of water and shade.
- $\Box$  Location of quarantine paddocks.

Additional requirements for applicants for EU certification:

- $\Box$  Cardinal directions.
- $\Box$  Geo-location of farm.

## **Facility Maps**

Processing or handling operations seeking organic certification must provide a detailed facility map as part of their application, unless no physical handling of product occurs (e.g., brokers/traders). This requirement also applies to producer operations that have an on-farm processing or handling facility. Please use the checklist below to ensure that you have included all required information on your facility map:

 $\Box$  Facility name and address.

□ Storage areas for organic and non-organic products, including ingredient, packaging material, in-process, and finished product storage.

- $\Box$  Processing areas and equipment for organic products.
- $\Box$  Location of pest control measures such as rodent bait stations.
- □ Any other significant site features related to the processing or handling of organic products.

## Additional requirements for applicants for EU certification:

 $\hfill\square$  Cardinal directions.

- $\Box$  Geo-location of facility.
- $\Box$  Size of facility (m<sup>2</sup>).
